In early 2,000, in Brosteni, Romania, Bread of Life Orphanage opened its doors to give hope and care to children, whose families were experiencing suffering and extreme poverty as a result of the closing of coal mines in 2000. In the past 10 years, Bread of Life has advanced their outreach to help feed more than 2,500 hungry children daily by opening 51 feeding centers in remote villages of Romania. 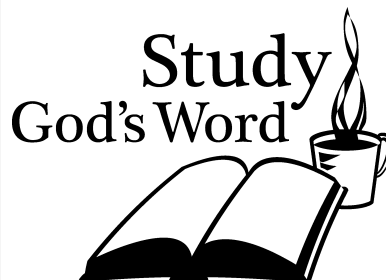

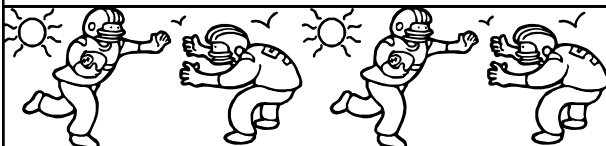
