- 1.) **Faithful Living** – Remember the Lord’s help. “God is our refuge and strength” – Psalm 46:1.
- 2.) **Worship** – In September, we are offering worship in these different formats.
 - a. Weekend Worship in the Sanctuary: Worship in the sanctuary is available at both sites according to the following schedule: Green Bay: Sat. – 5:00pm; Sun. 7:45am, 9:00am (Traditional), 10:30am (Contemporary). Suamico: – 9:00am & 10:30am (Blended).
 - b. Video Online Worship: Video worship is available on line at: www.pilgrimluth.org. Pilgrim has purchased a new camera system and developed a team of worship leaders and recording helpers to administer this system. We are presently purchasing additional recording resources as they become available. Thank you for your patience as we seek to improve our online ministry for worship, confirmation, Bible study, chapel and more.
 - c. Pilgrim Recorded Worship: We are offering a worship service recording (DVDs and CDs) for each Worship service. Upon request, we will mail them to you.
 - d. Worship on Wednesday: Worship on Wed. returns to the sanctuary in September, offering a new series on Forgiveness beginning Wed., Sept. 2 at 7:00pm. This service is also available online at Pilgrim’s website.

Wednesday evening students have the option of online classes. A password will be available to any students needing this option.
8. **Fellowship Opportunities** – As of Sept. 13 there will be fellowship opportunities after worship at both sites. Those desiring to share in conversation after worship can take advantage of this option; however, we are not offering food or beverages at the present time and masks are necessary for those in the fellowship hall.
