<u>Pilgrim's New Worship Protocol for Covid</u> - Pilgrim is NOW observing the following protocols or procedural changes for the month of August. We are still working on a month by month basis to provide excellent worship opportunities and a timely response for those in need of beneficial precautions regarding Covid. The following list provides our latest changes. We will observe these changes during the month of August.

- 1.all worship services and areas in the building are mask optional,
- 2. communion is served without masks/gloves, and kneeling & common cup return,
- 3. the nursery will be available but not staffed,
- 4. worship bags for children are available in the narthex,
- 5. fellowship Pads for worship/communion/guest registration are now in the pews,


