ABOUT

Confirmation is a practice or “rite” in which a person publicly admits (or “professes”) his/her faith in Jesus as Lord and Savior. This is a huge part of a persons faith journey, and we are beyond honored to be apart of yours! Confirmation is also about confirming the faith that God has created in us. We invite all young Christians who have been baptized into the Christian faith to be a part of our program starting in the 7th grade. Students can join later than the 7th grade year and start the two year process at the grade that they are in as well.

Confirmation on Wednesday Nights is for Pilgrim's Public School Students. Class begins at 6pm, with WOW (Worship on Wednesday)to follow! Pastor Malme, Pastor Hanson, Rebekah Spaulding, and Vicar Josh Duncan will lead the instruction through out the year. There will also be quizzes to complete before the next weeks lesson. Please notify us in advance if you will miss class. A weekly online option is not being offered this year.
