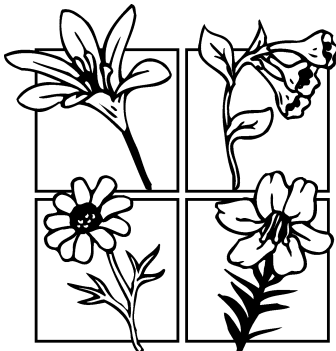

2nd Sunday after Pentecost

Mark 2:23-28

As you drive or ride along this week, pay attention to stop signs. Watch how other drivers react to a stop sign. Some drivers will do what police call on tickets a “rolling stop.” They will just slow down, but never come to a complete stop. At creation God gave us a weekly stop sign. It was called the “Sabbath.” Sabbath is Hebrew means “stop day.” It wasn’t designed to be a day that you just rolled through, but a day when you could, by God’s command, come to a complete stop. We have lost the concept of Sabbath rest. By rolling on through every day we increase our levels of stress. Ask God’s help to provide you periodically with a day when you come to a complete stop. It’s a blessing of God. Take it!
