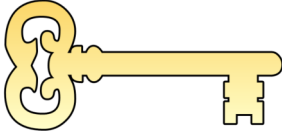

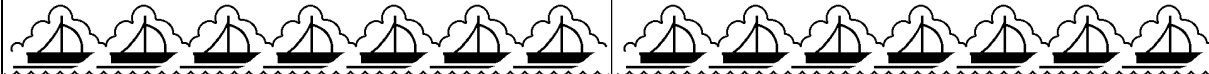
Prayer: *Almighty Maker, open our eyes to Your vision for life until it opens our mouths as well. Amen.*
