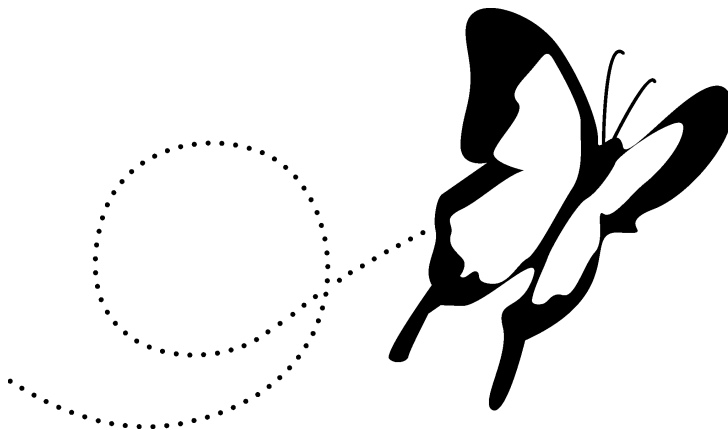

How does a hurricane praise God? Certainly those who are caught up in one don't think about a question such as this. Not many years ago extreme drought in the northeast during one summer was alleviated by the restoring, if heavy, rains of one hurricane remnant after another marching up the east coast. As creator and preserver of the world, God, by His rules established for weather, saw His rules work to balance things out. Those interviewed during the storms often said, "It's all in God's hands."
