# Stewardship

7th Sunday after Pentecost  
2 Corinthians 8:1-9, 13-14

What does it mean to be rich? Today's reading is a classic scripture on giving. But before we can be about the business of giving, we have to be good at receiving, and we don't do that very well. The Macedonians, held up as example by Paul, understand the depth of God's love for them. They recognized their riches through Christ. Now he reminds the Corinthians, "...Christ...for your sakes became poor, so that you, through his poverty, might become rich." When we consider what Christ gave up to come to earth, and what He suffered for us on the cross, God's love becomes evident. In receiving this love, we become rich beyond measure, for there is no price we can put on the gift of eternal life. In response to such giving, we also learn to give, from a position of uncommon wealth as a result of God's grace.
