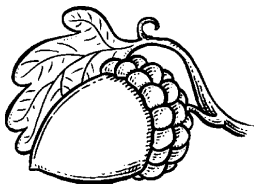

# Stewardship

20th Sunday after Pentecost  
Hebrews 2:9-11

It is “God, for whom and through whom everything exists.” This sentence in our reading for today sums up the doctrine of God’s creation and preservation. It also points out again for us that God is the owner and ultimate ruler over all things. And if Christ is our brother, then we are all God’s children, and, as it says elsewhere, “heirs of salvation.” An heir receives the property of the father. God, in His grace, has already distributed to you a good portion of His property. You have gifts and talents that allow you to be a productive person and earn a living and serve others. You have possessions to manage. You have the message of salvation to share. As you live your life, these, and all the other manifestations of God’s grace in your life are on loan from the Owner. The proof is that they are all “recalled” (the Greek term used when the rich man in Luke 12 died) by God at the time of death. So, while we live, let us make the best use of what God entrusts to us to manage.
